The right side should contain your response to each quotation (a question, commentary, analysis). Feel free to add the rows in the table, if necessary. When filling in the table, you may use the following prompts:
 - *I agree/disagree with..., because...*
 - *It is not clear for me...*
 - *I see the following challenges...*
 - *I have a question regarding...*
